 - In case of non-availability of students of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to ST category and vice-versa.
 - In case of non-availability of students of OBC-A category, the seats reserved for OBC-A may be converted to OBC-B category and vice-versa.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION

For the Students of Vidyasagar University

- i) As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 80% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U. and 20% seats will be available for Open Competition.
- ii) Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit, Marks obtained in Honours will be the sole criteria. Honours candidates of the current session and the immediately preceding session will be considered equally. In case of equal marks in Honours, total marks/percentage of marks of immediately preceding Examination is to be taken into account for ranking.
- iii) Quota for SC/ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906Edn/Estt dated 18-09-1997. Number of seats (SC-22%, ST-06%) will be calculated and considered separately for 80% seats of V.U. students and 20% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number. In case of non-availability of candidates of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to ST category and vice versa.
- iv) In case of non-availability of candidates of OBC-A category, the seats reserved for OBC-A may be converted to OBC-B category and vice versa.

- v) 3% of each category will be reserved for Persons with Disability (PWD) candidates; merit list will be prepared on the percentage of PWD. In case of non-availability of PWD candidate, the seat reserved for PWD will be converted to General Category.
- vi) Prize holders at International/National/state representation in the last two years will be considered for sports quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Competition/Inter College Athletic Meet organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. The sports events are Football, Volleyball, Athletic, Yoga, Khokho, Kabadi, Chess and Table Tennis. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.
- vii) Prize holders in the International/National /State meet in the last two years will be considered for cultural quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Cultural Competition organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.
- viii) 1% of total seats of all PG courses is reserved for sports/culture.
- ix) The seats for General candidates in the subject will be reduced by the No. of students selected for Sports/Cultural quota in the subject.
- x) Normally 80% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 20% seats for Open Competition. This 80% and 20% may be relaxed in case of non-availability of the applicants in either category.

For Open Competition:


- a) 20% seats in each subject are reserved for Open Competition.
- b) The students of other universities/autonomous college(s) will have to appear at the Entrance Test. The minimum marks for admission to PG courses through entrance test is as follows:
 - 45% marks in Hons. (for Gen. Candidates)
 - 40% marks in Hons. (for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD) candidates.
- c) The students of V.U. may appear at the Entrance Test & they have to secure the minimum marks as specified above.
- d) Questions will be MCQ pattern, Full Marks - 50, Total No. of Questions- 50, Time: One hour.
- e) Questions will be set in English.
- f) Counselling will be held for 80% seats first and after written admission test Counselling for 20% seats will be held in the college.
- g) The candidates, who will get admitted under 80% seats, will not be allowed to appear at the Written Admission Test for Open Competition.

Following documents have to be submitted by the candidate (On line):

1. Online Filled up application form to be submitted to the college Portal within 17-09-2024.
2. Self-attested photo copies of all the Mark Sheet of Examination passed (10th onwards), University Registration Certificate and a copy of the Passport size coloured photograph affixed on the box of the Form.

General Information:

Not only that, it promotes a healthy relationship between the teachers, the taught and the management to live a healthy community life, thereby making them imbibe a spirit of service and mutual co-operation, which is essential in the pursuit of knowledge.

The Sevayatan Sikshan Mahavidyalaya, one of the premier and oldest (Established in 1959) Teachers' Training Institute for Boys. Now it is co-educational institute and M.A. in education programme likely to be start formally. Now there are one boys' hostel and two girls hostels can house about 160 plus students (Boy-60 & Girls 100). The Boys hostel totally being repaired renovated and coloured under the financial help of Deptt. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal 2014-15 session.

The girls hostel newly constructed (2014) under financial support from UGC.

The hostels are nestled in bush green; eco-friendly surroundings with open play grounds. The hostels are being protected through boundary wall surroundings the hostels blocks. The whole hostel blocks are lighted at night with sufficient solar lights. During power failure the boarders can use solar light in their rooms. The guest rooms for visiting parents of students are also available. All in all, the hostel life in the campus is one of the most enviable among the student community, providing the students with a conducive atmosphere for learning.

- Only bonafide students of the Institute with valid student registration numbers of students having letter of admission issued by college office section are eligible to be given accommodation in the hostel.
- Absence from the hostel without permission from the Principal, Council of Wardens, may entail cancellation of membership.
- Though security arrangements are provided, the Institute shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to property belonging to the residents of the hostel.
- The occupant will use his or her own lock and key for locking the room and will be responsible for the safety of the belongings.
- The key of the room shall always be in possession of the member and handing over the key to any non-member or for the casual use by friends is strictly prohibited.
- Cooking in the rooms is strictly prohibited.
- Heaters or similar electrical appliances should not be used in the rooms.
- No extra furniture or electrical fittings are allowed in the rooms.
- Members should exercise all possible economy in the use of water and electricity.
- Members should keep their rooms clean and litter free.

- Members should take the responsibility of keeping the common areas like corridors, bathrooms, common rooms, game rooms tidy and litter free.
- The UGC has banned all types of “Ragging”. It is considered as a serious cognizable offense. There shall not be any type of ragging in the campus.
- Cooking of any type of food in the rooms is strictly prohibited.
- Consumption/storage of alcoholic beverages in the hostel premises is an offense. It is not permitted.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- Members should not cause disturbance to other residents in any manner whatsoever.
- Women visitors are not allowed in the men’s hostel. Similarly, male visitors are not allowed in women’s hostel.
- Members should not throw grabage/litter from balcony or windows.

Violation of these rules will be taken serious notice of and will result in disciplinary measures up to, and not excluding, expulsion from the hostel and the college.
